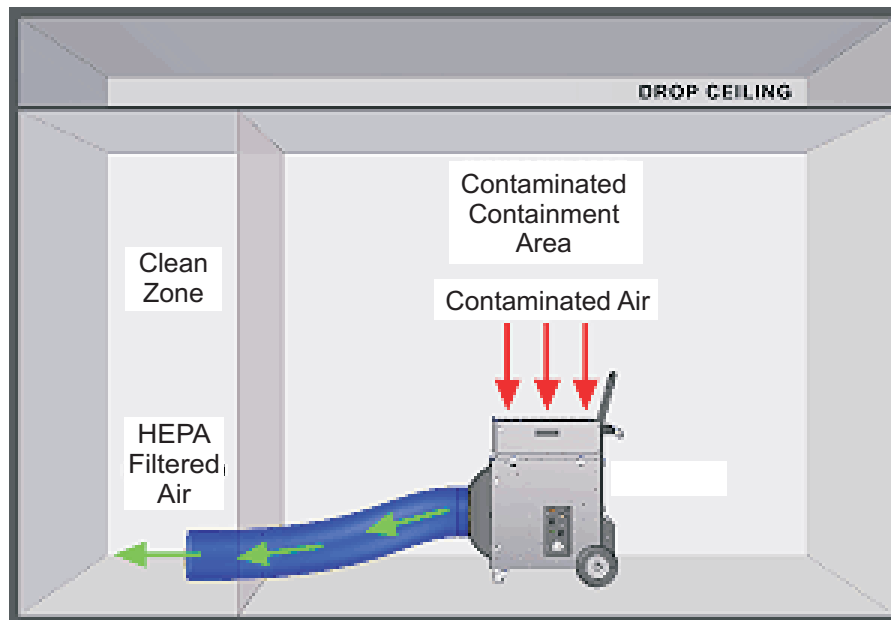


## CONTAINMENT (the most important step)



Containment is the most important part of any mold remediation process.

Without proper containment, mold conditions may and probably will become worse than before you started. Mold spores will migrate to other surfaces and areas of the home when disturbed, that's why containment is so important.

Anyone can clean, but only professional mold remedator's know how to effectively contain airborne mold spores and prevent spreading into other areas of the house, not to mention the air you breath. Proper containment may include a plastic zip wall, an air filtration device to filter the air in and around the containment area, and/or the ability to create negative pressurization within the containment zone.

Health effects associated with mold are serious, so should the clean up process. Containment needs to be in place prior to any mold cleanup or remediation process.
