



(03) OZONE and In-Door Air Quality



The American Lung Association says the Ozone Generator should not be used in anyone's home.

Ozone (03) is a highly reactive, colorless gas, each molecule of which is made up of three oxygen atoms. High in the atmosphere, the three-oxygen-atom ozone forms the ozone layer, which helps shield life on earth from the sun's damaging UV (ultraviolet) radiation.

At ground level, however, ozone is a pollutant, irritating eyes, nose and throat, and damaging the respiratory system. It is especially harmful to people with cardiorespiratory problems. Ozone also corrodes some metals. Furthermore, it has been demonstrated that ozone is not effective in controlling molds and fungi.

If you suspect you have mold problems in your home, ozone may not be the answer. Have the mold professionally tested and remediated. A small price to pay for a healthy in-door environment.
